CITY ANNOUNCES 2015 FALL LEAF PICKUP SCHEDULE

The City of Titusville will start its leaf pick up season soon. LEAF VACUUM EQUIPMENT IS NOT AVAILABLE. Street crews will collect BAGGED LEAVES IN BIO-DEGRADABLE BAGS ONLY from the area between the sidewalk and curbs, residents should take care to keep leaves off the street. Wet leaves on the street corridor can cause safety hazards. Residents should attempt to remove vehicles from the street 24 hours before scheduled pickup to aid in the collection process.

The regular schedule will be as follows:


- LIGHT BLUE SECTION: October 5th, 6th, 7th, and 8th; Oct. 26th, 27th, 28th, and 29th.
- BROWN SECTION: October 9th and 12th; October 30th, November 2nd, and 3rd.
- PINK SECTION: October 13th, 14th, and 15th; November 4th, 5th, and 6th.
- RED SECTION: October 16th, 19th and 20th; November 9th, 10th, and 11th.
- GREEN SECTION: October 21st, 22nd, and 23rd; November 12th, 13th, and 16th.
- The remainder of this week after the last scheduled day, and the following week will be utilized to attempt to retrieve any additional leaves missed during the two preceding rounds.

Each day's schedule is tentative and subject to change due to emergencies or weather conditions. The schedule will be adjusted to permit completions of the areas. Residents may bag leaves in areas already addressed and phone the DPW to place them on the list for pickup after the leaf crews have completed their rounds. Bagged leaves are to be in BIO-DEGRADABLE bags and should be leaves only. No sticks, stones, nuts, apples, etc... BIO-DEGRADABLE bags are available at; Morrison Builders; Titusville True Value, and Home Depot. Titusville residents may also dispose of bagged leaves at the designated site at the Waste Water Treatment Plant. This area is to the left of the main gate to the plant with an access road that leads to the appropriate area at the facility. **If residents take leaves down to this area in non-bio-degradable bags, please cut bags open & dispose of plastic bags in a responsible manner.**

THIS AREA IS FOR RESIDENTIAL USE ONLY, NO COMMERCIAL USAGE.

Residents should take care to keep the leaves off the street and keep them between the curb and the sidewalk, per Section 904.05 of the City's Ordinances. Wet leaves on the street can cause serious safety hazards.
