



<b>CALL TO ORDER</b>	The regular meeting of Titusville City Council was called to order by Mayor Smith in the 2 <sup>nd</sup> Floor Conference Room at Towne Square at 6:02 p.m.

<b>ROLL CALL</b>	Mayor Esther Smith, Deputy Mayor Bill Adelman (via phone), Councilman Keith Bromley, Councilman Don Frazier, & Councilwoman Heather Leonardi were present.
<b>NOTICE OF EXECUTIVE SESSION</b>	Notice of executive session after 1/16 work session regarding a legal matter.
<b>ADOPTION OF AGENDA</b>	<i>Motion</i> by Mr. Bromley, <i>second</i> by Mrs. Leonardi, and <i>carried unanimously</i> to adopt the agenda as prepared.

<b>PUBLIC PARTICIPATION</b>	<p><i>Eric Peterson – 317 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street</i> Spoke regarding the proposed parking ordinance for 3<sup>rd</sup> Street. Questioned why his one block was chosen as opposed to all of the other streets and blocks in town that are a problem. He insisted there has never been a plowing issue and he and his neighbors would gladly get stuff out of the way for the plows if asked.</p> <p><i>Jim Elliott – 306 North Franklin Street</i> Suggested the City use its extra right of way space and take Third Street and make it wider. Also questioned if there was a petition for the stop sign to be put in at the intersection of Perry and Oak.</p> <p><i>Susan Dibble – 428 East Walnut Street</i> Spoke regarding the one way street ordinance for East Walnut. She said the residents on this street should not be punished for a problem that belongs to the school district. She stated there are 14 houses on the block, seven of which are duplexes and provided a petition signed by all but three residents on her street not in favor of any changes. She added this type of change has been rejected by City Council three times in the past.</p> <p><i>Cheryl Rumbaugh – 423 East Walnut Street</i> Stated she seconded everything Susan Dibble said and questioned if the City would approach the school district about the issue and maybe permits could be issued for the school parking lots.</p>


*Susan Dibble – 428 East Walnut Street*


