II. Goals and objectives of the CDBG program

Federal Program – administered by PA Department of Community and Economic Development
Titusville is an entitlement community
Projects must meet one of three national objectives

Benefit to LMI persons – 70% of funds must benefit LMI. Specific area must be 51% LMI.
Elimination of slums/blight
Show an urgent need (i.e. tornado or flood damage)

III. Performance under previously funded CDBG program years

Street widening, new curbs, handicapped accessible corners, storm sewer installation, fire equipment purchases, blighted property demolitions (31 since 2011), street lights, wastewater treatment plant upgrades, East Walnut Street bridge construction, Burgess Park Splash Pad.

IV. Total amount of 2018 CDBG funds approximately \$272,000

V. Eligible activities

Housing rehab, street reconstruction, storm/sanitary sewer installation, demolition, removal of architectural barriers, historical preservation, parks, recreational facilities, public/community facilities renovations, fire equipment purchase, etc.
