**Open Public Hearing**

I. Introduction

The City of Titusville intends to apply to the Department of Housing and Urban Development for funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Small Cities Program.

This meeting is being conducted to give citizens another opportunity to comment on the City's proposed CDBG application before the City submits it to the DCED.

The City conducted its first public hearing on Tuesday, June 25, 2019 to discuss the CDBG program in general, the needs of the City of Titusville, performance under the previously funded CDBG program years, and to discuss the required Three Year Community Development Plan of the City of Titusville. There was no public comment at that meeting.

II. Goals and objectives of the program include

Goal: Funding Public Infrastructure and Community Facility Projects

Objectives: Benefit low to moderate income individuals and elimination of slums and blight

III. Total amount of 2019 CDBG funds available = \$298,504

IV. Proposed activities

The City is proposing to undertake the following activities for Fiscal Year 2019. None of the activities will result in the displacement of families or individuals. All projects meet the National Objective providing an Area Benefit. 53.68% of the entire City population is Low-to-Moderate income.
