INTRODUCTION TO MODIFICATION

City Manager Manross called the public hearing to order and explained the City intends to modify the 2018 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Small Cities Program application. The demolition of the Perry Street Bridge will not be demolished by PennDot until 2022. With funds needing to be used within three years they would potentially expire before the bridge is removed. He went on to say the meeting is being conducted to give citizens an opportunity to comment on the City's intention to modify use of funds for the renovation of the fire station to house the aerial truck donated to the City in May. Goal is to have this project done before the snow flies.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Larry Emerson – asked for clarification that that the change was for the roof over the Fire Station only and not the Police Station.


