CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Peden called the Special Meeting to order.

ROLL CALL

NEW BUSINESS

APPOINTMENT TO CITY COUNCIL

Motion by Mr. McCrillis, second by Mr. Crouch and carried unanimously to appoint Sara Jones to the vacant seat on City Council.

COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR CDBG PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION

Mr. Peden asked about the part of the agreement where 12% of the admin fees could come back to the City. The City Manager clarified that it could come to the City or be rolled back into the project.

Motion by Mr. Witosky, second by Mr. McCrillis and carried unanimously to enter the agreement with the Crawford County Planning office in the administration of CDBG funds.

James Elliott – 306 N. Franklin St. – Has anything new been filed with the Michael Crawford properties? An Order to Demolish is being drawn up, the City needs the demolition cost in order to do this so estimates are being requested. The vehicle in the front yard has been removed.
