City Council Special Meeting Proceedings August 7, 2020

CALL TO ORDER Deputy Mayor Crouch called the Special Meeting to order.

ROLL CALL Deputy Mayor Crouch, Councilman Witosky, Councilman McCrillis, Councilwoman Jones. Mayor Peden was excused as he was on vacation.

NEW BUSINESS
FIRST READING OF COUNCIL
BILL NO. 4 of 2020

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TITUSVILLE, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING SECTION 741.01, SECTION 943.03, AND SECTION 943.04 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF TITUSVILLE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERMITTING THE POSSESSION, SALE, PURCHASE, AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL ON CITY PROPERTY ONLY UPON APPROVAL BY CITY COUNCIL AND TO CLARIFY PROVISIONS RELATED TO EVENT PERMITS.

Up until now ordinances have prohibited alcohol in City parks. This amendment would allow City Council to grant permission to groups applying for a Special Event permit to have alcohol in the park.

Motion by Mr. Witosky, second by Mrs. Jones and carried unanimously to approve Council Bill No. 4 of 2020 upon first reading.

PUBLIC INPUT James Elliott – 306 N. Franklin St. – You stated that there are exceptions? Mr. Crouch clarified that the amendment allows there to be exceptions to the ordinance but only granted by City Council. Does this mean Orr’s can sell wine at their event? The ordinance doesn’t specify which types it’s just alcohol.

COMMENTS BY MAYOR AND COUNCIL Mr. Witosky stated it was a step in the right direction. It allows for more than just a brew fest or wine walk at Oil Fest. Mr. McCrillis was glad it was brought to Council’s attention about alcohol in City parks. They could have been in trouble if they had allowed the Wine Walk. Mr. Crouch stated that maybe we could have an Oktoberfest and makes it a more people friendly town. He also asked City Manager Neil Fratus what the cost for trash/bag dispenser posts for parks would cost. He also wondered if Council had just done a resolution regarding dogs in the park or if there was an ordinance. Mr. McCrillis asked if there would be fines for people who don’t comply with picking up after their dogs.


